ISSUES A CALL FOR APPLICANTS FOR CAPITAL
REGION COLLABORATION INITIATIVES**

Albany, N.Y. April 4, 2017. – The Humane Society of the Capital Region announces four \$1,500 grants to be awarded June 30, 2017 that advance any or all of the following three grant objectives:

- Collaborative efforts/programs/events between established 501(c)(3) animal welfare organizations
- Collection and reporting of data on animal intake, adoptions, and euthanasia tracking for three or more organizations collaboratively
- Measurement and reporting of program outcomes

Initiatives that include two or more of the objectives with a collaboration of three or more organizations may be eligible for multiple grants.

Applicants meeting the following criteria are encouraged to apply

Service area: Within any of the counties of Albany, Columbia, Greene, Fulton, Montgomery, Rensselaer, Saratoga, Schenectady, Schoharie, Warren, and Washington

Minimum age of organization: Organizations with 501(c)(3) status obtained prior to 1/1/2014

Grant application criteria

Deadline for receipt of completed applications: May 31, 2017

Application to include the following

- Mission of organization
- Description of initiatives of proposed grant (must fit within the above three grant objectives)
- Budget
- Project timeline
- 990s or 990EZ forms for 2014, 2015 and 2016
- Contact name with email and phone number.
